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CHÂTEAU GREYSAC MÉDOC 2015

Riper than many 2015s from this appellation and with a healthy tannic base, this Medoc has a lot going for it. There's a hint of menthol on the nose, but also something savory and plenty of ripe red berries. Drink now.




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CHÂTEAU HAUT CONDISSAS MEDOC PRESTIGE 2015

Big black fruits nose with just a hint of bell pepper, then a full, almost lush palate make this a self-confidently modern style of Medoc. If it were a bit longer on the finish it would rate more highly. Drink now or in 2019 and 2020.



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CHÂTEAU LA CLARE MEDOC 2015

Only medium-bodied and not showy, the strong suit of this wine is the very good balance. It needs some air for the discreet black-fruit aromas to open up and will therefore probably be better from 2019.



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CHÂTEAU TOUR SERAN MEDOC 2015

At once fresh, herbal and savory, this rather sleek wine has enough dry tannin to give it some length and character. With a bit more upfront fruit, it would rate more highly. Drink now or in 2019 and 2020.



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CHÂTEAU ROLLAN DE BY MEDOC 2015

This isn't showy or dramatic, but it has classic Medoc character and an elegantly dry balance. The finish is also longer than most 2015 Medoc wines, and that suggests this is only going to get better through at least 2025.
